

The Lateral Grid Header (left side of matrix; y-axis)

- spells out P.A.R.K.S. (Where do you park your car/life?)
- Prudent, Acknowledge, Recognize, K(c)ommit, Seek & Serve
- developed from Deuteronomy 6







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
The Horizontal Grid Header (top of matrix; x-axis)

- contains the 7 Components (i.e. aptitudes, competencies, know-hows) of P.A.R.K.S
- spiritual, moral, intellectual, physical, emotional, social, financial

 - Phone call or text (varies based on service/phone type)
 - FB messenger call or text (video calls work great!)
 - Key Communication Items:
 - Encouragement!
 - Truth! (use of P.A.R.K.S. Videos)
 - Schedule! (when will you see him or her next?)
 - Transportation! (do you need to pick-up/drop-off him or her for the event?? What location will he or she be at?)

Car rides are KEY CONNECTION TIME!

Please take the initiative with <u>COMMUNICATION</u>

- Communicate with your Apprentice's Parent/Guardian/Older Sibling
 - Even if there is not a response!
 - Key Communication Items:
 - What your Apprentice has learned / accomplished
 - The schedule
 - Transportation
 - Ask questions how can we be praying for you and your family? how is your job going? how is the Apprentice doing in school? Etc.

- Personal prayer requests, needs, struggles how can we support you YOU ARE A PART OF THE JCLC TEAM! (not just a "volunteer")


Please take the initiative with <u>COMMUNICATION</u>


